



Tailors' Union and The Pocket's commitment to the safety and well-being of all guests and team members has long been a part of its values and operating procedures. In an effort to ensure the ultimate guest experience during this pandemic, Tailors' Union has implemented a number of protocols around proper food handling and safety, sanitation, staff training on health policies, and more. Some ways you'll see Tailors' Union's commitment include the following new policies once we re-open:

- Maintain six feet distance between all persons
- Limit the number of guests into Tailors' Union/The Pocket following state and local occupancy limitations
- All guest seating has been rearranged to allow appropriate social distancing
- Increased cleaning and sanitation throughout, including wipe downs using disinfectant solutions on tables and seating areas after each use, hourly wipe downs of high contact areas including, but not limited to, handrails, door handles and restrooms.
- Provide hand sanitizer stations at the entrance and throughout the building
- Frequent handwashing by all team members (at least every 30 minutes)
- All team members are required to wear mask at all times
- We encourage guests to wear a mask, although not required
- Conduct daily contactless temperature checks on all staff members at the beginning of each shift
- Paper menus will be distributed and thrown away after each use
- Guests are asked to remain in their booth/section as much as possible to control social distancing
- Use of disposable glassware, flatware and plates/containers
